## PRESENTATION

Dear Colleagues, we are pleased to invite you to the 2nd LIMPE Seminar "Old and New Dopamine Agonists: a Reappraisal", which will be held at the Congress Center of Pisa (Italy) from February 26 to 28, 2009. Many years after the introduction of these drugs in the therapeutic armamentarium of Parkinson's disease and the previous meeting in Pisa of 1993, dopamine agonists have today a well established role in the disease. - Abstract text is limited to a maximum of 250 words. Figures and tables are not allowed.
- E-mail address of presenting author.

The presentation of each poster is subject to the prepayment of the registration fee to the Conference.


#### HOW TO REACH THE CONFERENCE VENUE
